- Aspirin (81 or 325mg)
- Tylenol, Advil (Adult and Child)
- Children's Liquid Tylenol, Children's Liquid Advil
- Cough/Cold Syrups (Adult and Child)

Allergy/Itch/ Stomach Medications

- Benadryl
- Triple Antibiotic Ointment (Neosporin)
- Hydrocortisone (Anti-itch cream)
- Antifungal Ointments/ Powders (Tinactin)
- Antacids (Tums)
